50th REUNION FAQs

Q: I am concerned about the cost of the reunion. What should I expect?

A: The reunion committee respects and understands that cost is a major factor in determining reunion attendance and is working hard to plan a program that will be both reasonably priced and of a high quality. More detailed information is forthcoming and confidential financial assistance will be available. Your registration materials will arrive by early April, allowing you to register online or via return mail. A typical 50th Reunion full package covering all events for four days typically runs around \$650 per person. Additional pricing options will be available.

Q: I am driving to the reunion. Where will I park?

A: 50th Reunion attendees are encouraged to park at the Business School parking lot on Western Avenue. Shuttle bus service and reunion vans will be available for transport to and from 50th headquarters in Quincy House.

Q: I need a place to stay. Where will the Class of 1960 be housed?

A: On-campus housing will be available for 50th Reunion alumni and their guests at the Harvard Houses. With access to reunion staff bellhops and van drivers, each registered guest will receive a towel, soap, sheets, blanket, and pillow. You need not worry about registering for housing until you receive your reunion registration packet in April 2010. Should you wish to pursue hotel accommodations independently, there is a helpful list of area hotels we have blocked a limited number of rooms at favorable rates. 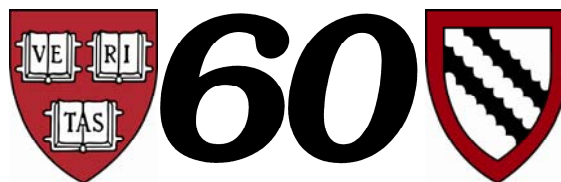
Q: Will there be Radcliffe Day events on Friday, May 28?
